Sightseeing *attractions*

Recognised by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site, Ha Long Bay captivates visitors with thousands of limestone islands rising from emerald waters.

Spiritual – Cultural *attractions*



Yen Tu Mountain & Pagoda Complex

Known as the cradle of Vietnamese Zen Buddhism, Yen Tu is a sacred mountain where ancient temples and pagodas blend harmoniously with misty forests. Visitors can take a cable car or hike to the summit, visit the Dong Pagoda, and immerse themselves in a peaceful spiritual atmosphere surrounded by nature.



Ba Vang Pagoda

Perched on the mountainside in Uong Bi City, Ba Vang Pagoda stands out with its grand architecture, tranquil courtyards, and panoramic views. As one of northern Vietnam's most famous spiritual sites, it offers visitors a serene space for prayer, reflection, and Buddhist learning amid beautiful scenery.



Bao Hai Linh Thong Pagoda

Majestic and serene, Bao Hai Linh Thong Pagoda sits atop Bai Tho Mountain, offering panoramic views of Ha Long Bay. The pagoda combines traditional Vietnamese architecture with spiritual tranquility, making it an inspiring destination for meditation and contemplation above the clouds.

Yoko Onsen Quang Hanh

Bai Chay & Hon Gai Beach

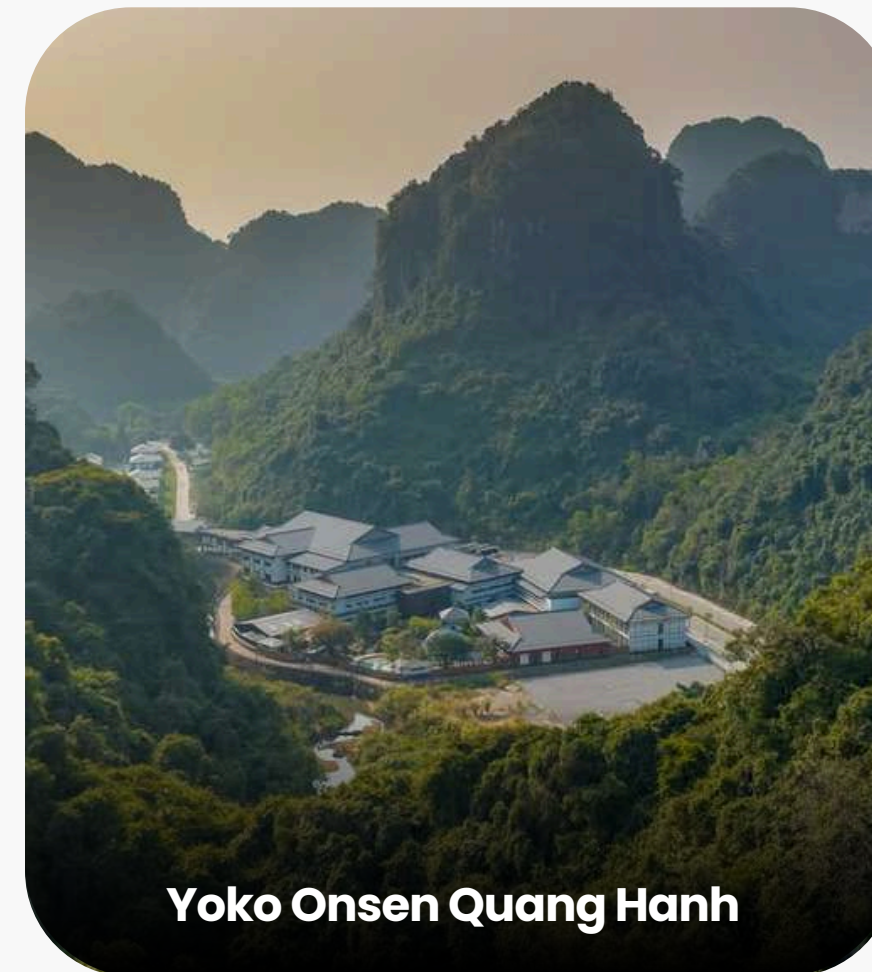

Dragon Pearl Cave Dinner & Cultural Show

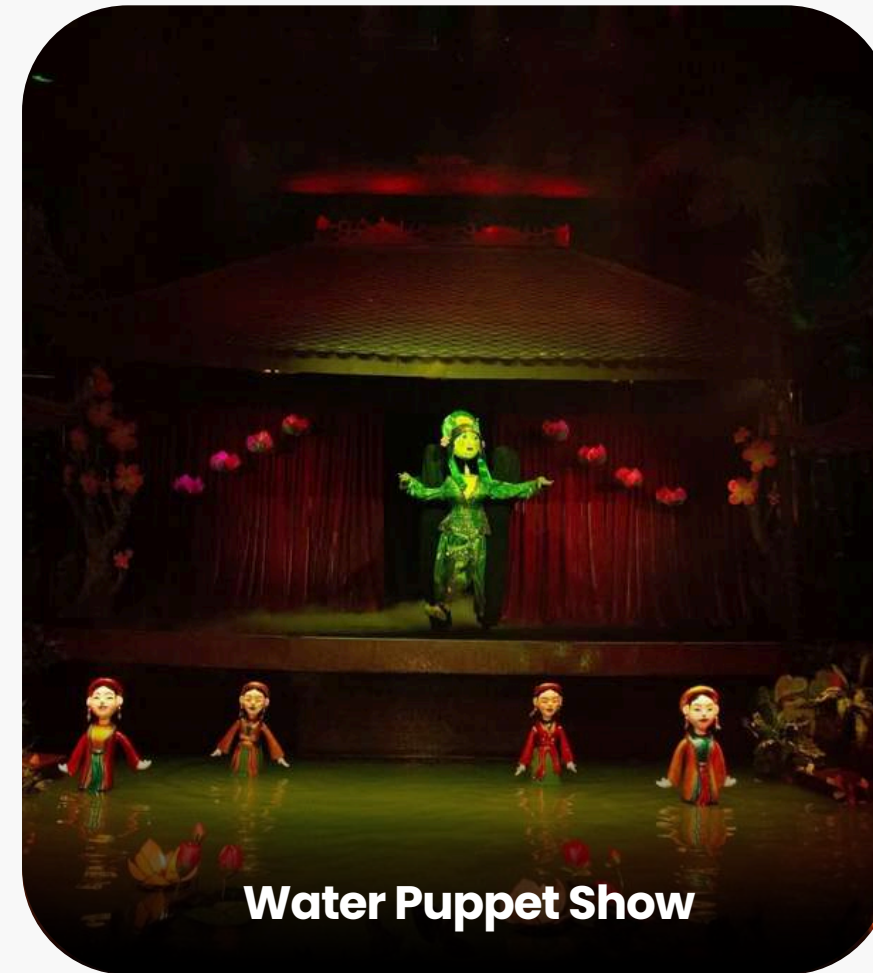

Seaplane Excursion

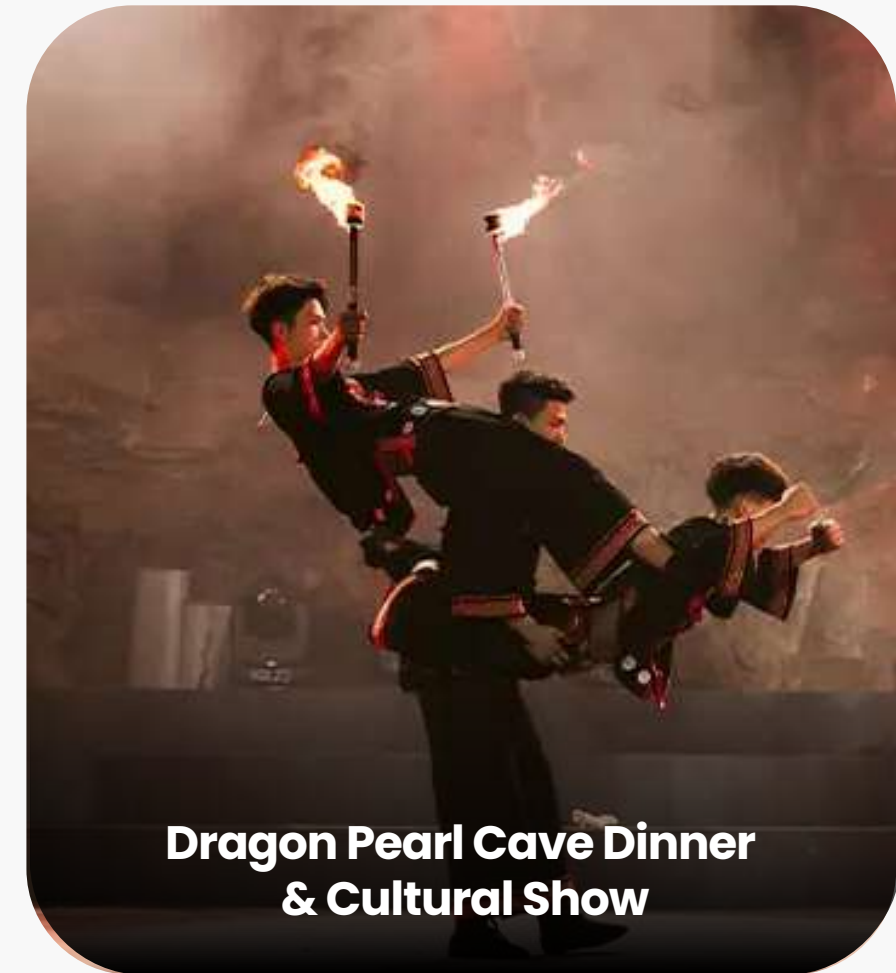

Oyster Farm

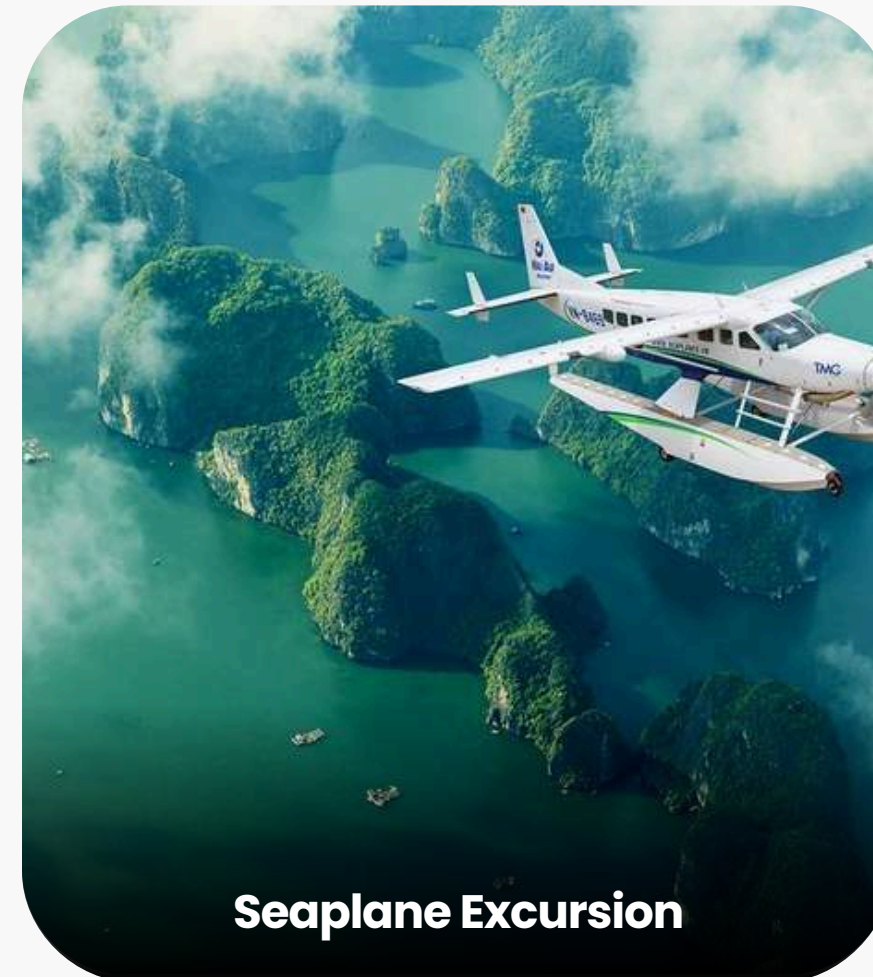
